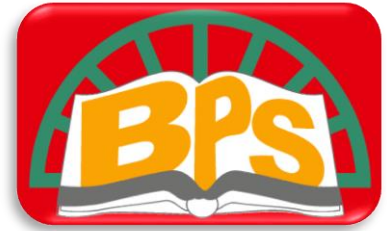

We all hope that you have had a wonderful summer break and are ready to start the new school year.

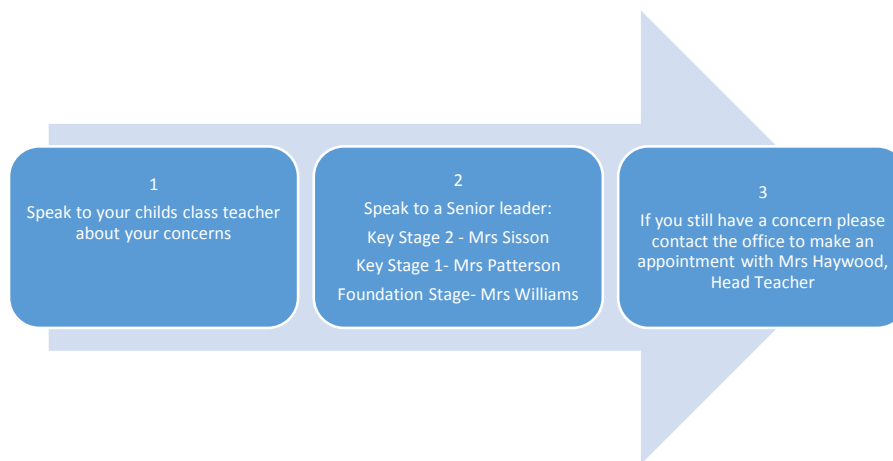
