Sports Coach – 1.5 days a week plus lunchtime club	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All children taught by qualified coach for at least ½ term 1 hour a week - Lesson plans and schemes of work are provided - Lacrosse being taught in KS2 in second half of Autumn Term (teaching staff have never taught this before) - Weekly lunch time club for identified children- linked to the Sainsburys Active Schools Award - Members of staff observe the coach teaching their own class weekly and evaluate – feedback given to Coach/head/ PE coordinator - After school club for KS2 and KS1 children - 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - More children are taking part in PE clubs - Whole school PE assessments show that children are making good progress - Staff have a clearer understanding of effective PE provision - Observations of staff teaching PE show that teachers are implementing new strategies taught - Staff take up more after school PE opportunities - School attain at least a silver medal from the Sainsbury’s Active School Awards - The percentage of children reaching an expected and better than expected level of attainment improves.
