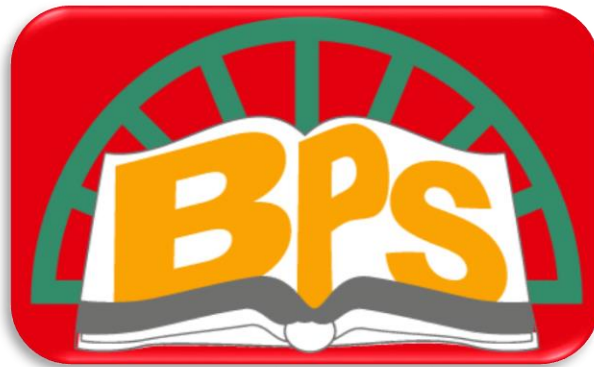

<p>Stepped Sanctions</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Reminder of their behaviour 2. Caution/warning 3. Last chance script 4. Time out 5. Reconciliation talk 	<p>Last chance script</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sit next to the child. - 'I have noticed....' (what they have done wrong) - 'We are working on....' (whole class activity/ target). - 'If you continue to make this choice you will be put in time out'. - Walk away. 	<p>Serious Breaches</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hurting another child • Not respecting property • Swearing • Disrespectful behaviour • Continuation of behaviour after last chance script. <p style="text-align: center;">  Straight to TIME OUT (1 minute per year of age) </p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Rewards</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Well Done Dots and Star Charts • Beak of the Week/ Term/ Year • Postcards home for 'Above and Beyond' • Lunchtime awards given in assembly • Milkshakes and baking for 'Above and Beyond' and 'Beak of the Week' children • Golden Table at lunchtime for 'Beak of the Week' children
